- Small setting – One teacher to Five students Ratio (to allow for more personalized instruction)
- Math is GPSCC Aligned – to help prepare students for Standardized Tests
- On-line Computer Laptop Program – Students do this program on-line. They take diagnostic test and are assessed throughout the on-line Math Program to ensure they are learning and mastering various math concepts before moving on to the next level.
- This Math Program includes students in 6th through 12th Grade.
- Supplements and strengthens what students are learning in their math classes.
- Breakfast provided

The DeKalb Alternative School Math Instructional Supplement Program is FREE and strictly voluntary for parents to have their child participate.
